



The California Middle School XC Championships has been created for elementary & middle school athletes (grades 3-8) throughout the state of California to come together and compete for a chance to be called the best in the state. The championships will be held on Friday October 13<sup>th</sup> on the very popular Riverside Cross Country Course, home of many high-level XC invites and the CIF Southern Section Championships. This course is flat, fast, and spectator friendly.

We will be offering grade level and team sweepstakes races. Elementary (grades 3-5) will compete along a 1 mile looped course, while middle schoolers (grades 6-8) will compete along a 2 mile looped course. Sweepstakes teams may consist of any 7 members of your team's roster (grades 6-8 only).

Athletes wishing to compete must be currently enrolled in grade 3-8 in an accredited California school. Athletes will compete as official members of their schools cross country program and must be accompanied by an official member of their school's coaching staff (open, club, and unattached athletes will not be allowed to compete).

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### **TIMING**

We will be utilizing chip timing from Finished Results. All runners must wear the bib and timing chip assigned to them or they will be disqualified. Any changes must be done prior to the athlete competing once they have finished their race no name changes will be allowed.



### **SCORING**

The first five runners of a team will score. The 6th and 7th runners on each team will displace. Teams who finish with fewer than 5 runners will not be calculated in team scoring. Results will be available approximately 25 minutes after the last runner finishes.

### **AWARDS**

All races will have medals for the top 60 individual finishers, overall winning team in grade level races, top 3 teams in the Sweepstakes race.

### **DRESSING QUARTERS**

All competitors are asked to arrive at the course dressed. Lockers and towels will not be available.

### **FOOTWEAR**

For safety purposes, spiked shoes (even with spikes removed) are **NOT ALLOWED** at the California Middle School XC Championship course. Non spiked cross country shoes are allowed.

### **MEDICAL POLICY**

**IMPORTANT! PLEASE REVIEW THE MEDICAL POLICY AND INFORMATION : Liability Waiver Required.**

The top priority of our medical staff is to respond to life threatening medical emergencies.

Non-life threatening/minor injuries (example: scraped knees, minor cuts, etc.) may be treated if resources are available and time allows. Serious injuries take precedence and will be treated first.

### **PARKING**

There will be a \$10 parking fee for all vehicles. Once buses have dropped off the athletes and coaches they will be instructed to drive over to where to park at that time.



## Registration Rules and Policies

- All entries must be made through a representative of the school that is entering the competition.
- All athletes must run for the school they attend. No unattached or club affiliated runners.
- All athletes must run in their respective age divisions with the exception of varsity races.
- All athletes must run under their own name.

Corrections will be made to the results. Corrections on meet day cannot be guaranteed, but will be posted by Monday, October 23<sup>rd</sup>.
