PAYMENT: There will be no cost to the team. We will charge at the gate for

spectators. \$5 per person.

COACHES MEETING: Coaches Meeting will take place at 2:00 PM at the starting line. Please be

prompt!

STADIUM OPENS: Stadium will be open at 1:00PM.

CLERK OF THE COURSE: Will be located at the South-East Corner of the stadium (Shot put and

parking lot side) Competitors will receive lane and number assignments there. Please report ready to compete. All competitors will be escorted to

the competition area.

ENTRIES : All entries will be made on EPISports.com

RELAY TEAMS: Each team will be allowed to enter 1 varsity team (B teams will be

allowed to fill the lanes, seeded by time) and up to 3 teams in open division per level. There will be 1 heat each of varsity, then 2 heats of

open, lanes will be seeded according to time.

FIELD EVENTS: Each team will be allowed to enter up to 4 individuals per event per level.

They will not be scored as a team. Vertical jumps will employ a 5 alive format. Two high jump pits will be used. There are minimum measure marks for all events. All throws and horizontal jumps will have 3 attempts with top 9 moving on to finals. We will use flights of up to 12 athletes Long and triple jumps will have 2 hour open pit, then 1 hour finals. Pole Vault will be competed as an open event only, with the bar being raised by

9" for the first 2 heights, then 6" thereafter. Ex. 8', 8'9", 9'6", 10",

10'6"......

TIMING: Timing will be by Finished Results. All results will be posted on

FinishedResults.com and PrepCalTrack.com at conclusion of meet.

EQUIPMENT: Teams furnish own batons, throwing implements, and pole vault poles.

AWARDS: No medals will be awarded.

SNACK BAR: Full Snack Bar will be available.

TRASH: Each team is responsible for cleaning up the trash in their area. Please be

considerate of this throughout meet. There will be a large trash bag in your

team packet to help with the process.

CANOPIES: No canopies will be allowed in the stands. Please use the warm-up field

for this.

NO RADIOS: No radios will be allowed at the meet.

RESTROOMS: Restrooms are available

ATHLETES/COACHES: All athletes will be in the stands or warm-up area when not competing and

coaches must remain off the field and track during the meet. Head coaches

only will be allowed on the field.

3/16" PYRAMID SPIKES ONLY: All runners and jumpers/vaulters must have 3/16th inch pyramid

spikes, NO PIN/NEEDLE Spikes will be allowed. All spikes will be

checked at gate and again at starting line. Spikes will be on sale for \$3.00.

RAINOUT DATE: The meet will be held rain or shine.
