

# Twenty Second Annual Diamond Valley Lake Invitational

**When:** Thursday, November 9<sup>th</sup>, 2023

**Time:** 10:30 am – 1:30 pm (self guided course tour, must be off course by 10:15 am)

**Who:** Boys and Girls in grades 6<sup>th</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> (six separate races)

Race Order: 6<sup>th</sup> grade girls – 10:30 am      6<sup>th</sup> grade boys – 10:55 am

7<sup>th</sup> grade girls – 11:20 am      7<sup>th</sup> grade boys – 11:45 am

8<sup>th</sup> grade girls – 12:10 pm      8<sup>th</sup> grade boys – 12:35 pm

**Races will be run ahead of schedule, if time allows.** Meet is held rain or shine. Meet officials can cancel/postpone the meet for unseen circumstances.

**Course:** 2.0 miles primarily on a dirt road. A few rolling hills and 1 large hill.  
Start line is on pavement and finish line is on grass.

**Fee:** \$45.00 per race or \$20.00 each athlete

**\* Entry fee is based on number of registered athletes, not the number of athletes that show up the day of the meet.**

#### **Awards:**

- Medals to top 30 finishers in each race.      - Plaques to top three teams in each race.
- Trophy to top male and female team (all grades combined).

**Scoring:** top 5 score, need at least five for a team

**Concessions:** Food and drink vendor will be available.

**Free Food For Team Coach** (1 coach per team is eligible for free food)

**T-shirts:** Shirts will be sold for \$15.00 each. **\$10.00 shirt coupon for head coach**

**Team Care:** Please make sure you bring **WATER and first aid supplies** for your team.
