AGE DIVISIONS & ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

8 and under (born 2011+)
9 - 10 (born 2009 - 2010)
11 - 12 (born 2007 - 2008)
13 - 14 (born 2005 - 2006)
15 - 16 (born 2003 - 2004)
17 - 18 (born 2001 - 2002)
<i>* athletes born in 2000 are also eligible if they do not turn 19 on or before 7/28/2019</i>



Individuals: Only U.S. citizens, aliens living in the United States and foreign exchange students are eligible to compete in these Championships. See the USATF Rules for more information and exceptions. A competitor must compete in his/her age division only. There will be no "moving up" in any events, including relays. Competitors in the 8 & Under 9-10 and 11-12 age divisions may compete in a maximum of three (3) events, including relays. Competitors in the 13-14, 15-16 and 17-18 age divisions may compete in a maximum of four (4) events, including relays. Combined events are not included in the event count. All athletes must be 2019 members of USATF in good standing.

Rule 300 I (c): *Athletes must be at least seven (7) years of age on December 31 of the current year to compete in the Youth Athletics or Junior Olympics National Championship.* Any athlete who does not meet this requirement will not be able to advance to the Junior Olympics National Championship.

Relay Teams: Only registered 2019 USATF member clubs may enter a relay team(s). All athletes representing the club must be affiliated with and members of that club as part of their USATF membership. Visit www.usatf.org/membership.

ENTRY PROCESS: Individual Entries: **\$7 dollars** per event -- Relay Entries: **\$28 dollars** per relay team.

On-Time Registration: Club Administrators and Unattached Athletes should register online at: <http://athletic.net>. You will then scroll down the calendar to the USATF-Nevada Association meet on June 7-9. You will then be prompted to log in or register. ENTRIES ARE DUE **BY JUNE 5, 2019 at 11:59 pm PST**. Online registration opens **May 28, 2019**. **Fees must be paid online by the close of registration.** Accuracy of data entered is the responsibility of each club and/or athlete. Please validate data within Athletic.net for accuracy prior to submitting entry. All athletes competing in the multi's must also register for your entries (Triathlon, Pentathlon, Decathlon, and Heptathlon) at the Association level. The Multi's Regional Championships will take place on July 13-14, 2019 in Las Vegas, NV (Location TBA). Please contact Stacey Cooper at: president@nevada.usatf or (702) 885-1471. After submitting your team/individual information, you should receive a confirmation of completed entries. Should any questions arise about your team entries at the Association Championships, you **MUST** show your confirmation sheet to prove your entries into the meet. Please ensure that the membership chair has received a copy of the athlete's Proof of Birth, in a timely manner. All athletes must be birthdate verified in order to enter into the meet via the online registration system. **Valid 2019 USATF Membership and Proof of Birth is needed to compete if they are not already verified.** (Please contact Jeanetta Edmond if you

do not know if your athlete is verified). Athlete's Proof of Birth can include a copy of birth certificate, passport, certified baptismal record, driver's license, or U.S. government identification. See Rule 300.1 (i) for further explanation.

AWARDS: USATF Junior Olympic medals will be awarded to the top three (3) individuals and the top three (3) relay teams in each event of each age division.

ADVANCEMENTS: The top 8 athletes and relay teams in each event of each age division will advance to the USATF Region 15 Championships to be held on **June 21–23, 2019 at Coronado High School in Henderson, NV.** More info can be obtained at: www.nevada.usatf.org.

***The National Junior Olympic Championships will be held from Monday, July 22nd through Sunday, July 28th in Sacramento, CA. The top 5 athletes at the Region **15** Championships will qualify for the National Championships. In combined events, the top 2 athletes will automatically qualify. In addition to the top 2 athletes, anyone that meets the qualifying standard in the combined events will also qualify. The standard for each combined event will be published later. IMPLEMENT WEIGH-IN:

All implements must be weighed for competition on Friday, June 7 by 3:30pm at UNLV for events at UNLV and Saturday June 8 by 8am for events at Coronado HS).

EVENT CHECK-IN: There will be separate check-in areas for Running and Field events. Running events will check in at the clerking tent, Field events will check in at the event site. Athletes must check in at these designated areas 30 minutes prior to the event's scheduled starting time. All athletes will be required to remain in the designated warm-up areas after checking in.

COMPETITION BIB NUMBERS: All competitors must wear their assigned bib numbers during competition and on the front on their jerseys only. If an athlete loses the bib number, a replacement can be purchased for a fee of \$5. Bib numbers will be distributed to athletes **packet pick up area starting at 7 AM.**

EVENT RESULTS: During competition, event results will be posted online at <http://www.finishedresults.com>.

PROTESTS: There will be a \$75 fee for all protests. Protests must be submitted to the Protest Referee at once and not later than 30 minutes after a result has been announced or posted. The protest fee will be refunded if the protest is upheld.

1. USATF Registration/athletic.net website

- Please remember that when registering at the USATF Registration/athletic.net, a VALID email address and phone number MUST be used. This email address or phone may be used to notify the coach and/or athlete of any changes that will take place at the meet.
- Please do not forget to fill out the Participant Waiver and Release Form for each athlete competing in the USATF NV Assoc Championship. The form is attached to this document or can be found (along with this packet) online at: <http://www.nevada.usatf.org>

2. Late Fees

- All entries are due by June 5, 2019 at 11:59 PM PST through the www.athletic.net website.
- If there are changes or additions to your entries after the above date, you must contact Kisha Finch at: ahsikfinch@aol.com or (202) 421-9569 by Thursday, June 6, 2017 at 10 PM PST. There is a \$5 dollar late fee per athlete.
- **ALL LATE FEES MUST BE PAID prior to packet pickup. NO EXCEPTIONS.**

3. Javelin and Hammer Throws and Steeplechase Events –

- The Hammer and Javelin Throws and 2000m Steeplechase events will take place at UNLV on Friday, June 7. **The Hammer Throw will begin promptly at 4pm.**

4. ACT

- If you have an athlete who will be taking the ACT on June 8, they may be able to obtain a bye to the finals on Sunday or the Region 15 Championship. The athlete must first submit proof of ACT Registration to **the Association via email (secretary@nevada.usatf.org)** by June 6, 2019, along with the name, age division and event (s) to be missed on Saturday June 8, 2019. Additionally, the athlete must then present a copy of the certificate of ACT test completion to Youth Chair on Saturday June 8 **before 2pm.**
- If there are multiple athletes who missed their event and took the ACT, the person (s) who first confirmed attendance on June 6 and subsequently turned in the above paperwork on June 8, will be given priority.
