POLE VAULT EQUIPMENT:	<ul> <li>All competitors must supply their own poles.</li> <li>Pole/equipment storage is available for competitors.</li> <li>If you are shipping poles, please ship to:         Giovanni Lanaro, Track and Field/1100 N. Grand Ave./Walnut, CA 91789</li> <li>Those needing to store or ship poles, must make <u>prior</u> arrangements with the Meet Director.</li> </ul>	
TEAM CAMPS:	<ul> <li>All camps must be set up in the South Field Area or in the stadium grandstands.</li> <li>NO team camps allowed inside the track.</li> </ul>	
WARM UPS:	Warm-ups will be allowed on the main facility except during competition	
ATHLETIC TRAINERS:	<ul> <li>The Mt. SAC Athletic Training Staff will provide emergency treatment for all competitors.</li> <li>Work areas for visiting trainers can be arranged by contacting the Mt.
