2023 PACWEST CROSS COUNTRY CHAMPIONSHIP INFORMATION

COURSE INFO: Fresno Pacific University is excited to host the 2023 PacWest Cross Country Championship at Woodward Park. Located in North Fresno along the San Joaquin River, Woodward Park is the competitive home for the FPU Men's and Women's Cross Country programs. As one of the best cross country courses in the Western U.S., Woodward Park has hosted major meets like the NCAA Division I Regional, the Kinney Meet and the 2014 and 2018 PacWest Conference Men's and Women's Cross Country Championships. It was the annual home of the GSAC Cross Country Championships and is the host site for the CIF Central Section and State Championship Meets. A mild rolling terrain, Woodward's course is 20 percent asphalt and 80 percent dirt trails. The park runs several courses of varying lengths, including 5K, four mile, 6K, 8K, and 10K courses. All of the courses cover the same area and repeat many of the same miles, with the first and last mile identical for all courses. The courses have remained the same through the years, allowing for consistent times and records.

ENTRY FEE

\$300 per team (limit 12 entries per gender; teams must declare 10 competitors from athletes entered). Invoices have been emailed to ADs and will be paid to the conference office.

ENTRY DEADLINE

Entries will open Monday, October 2, and close on <u>Sunday, October 15 (at midnight PDT)</u>, via Direct Athletics. Entry information will be sent to coaches when entries open. Coaches may enter up to 12 athletes (only 10 may compete); final declaration of 10 championship participants is due no later than 5:00 pm on Friday, Oct. 20. Coaches may declare their 10 participants to conference office and meet director at packet pickup at the course on the practice day.

TIMING

Finished Results will be the timer. Chip timing will be used, and we will have live results via the Finished Results website or mobile applications. Results will be uploaded directly to TFRRS after the meet. A PDF copy of the results will also be sent directly to each school's SID and posted at FPUATHLETICS.com and ThePacWest.com

DIRECTIONS & PARKING

From the North: From California Highway 99, take the Herndon Avenue Exit and travel east. Turn left on Blackstone Avenue (turns into Friant Road) and travel approximately 3.5 miles, Woodward Park will be on your left.

From the South: From California Highway 99, take California Highway 41 north. Take the Friant Road Exit and turn right, Woodward Park will be on your left side.

Parking: Parking (\$5) is available inside the park. Please park in the Mountain View Shelter parking lot near the Start/Finish Line. If entering the park off Audubon, stay to the right once entering the park. Lot is the second parking lot on the left once past the entrance kiosk. If entering the park off of Friant, pass the kiosk and stay on the main road until it "T's" into the main road circling the park. Turn left, and look for the Mountain View Parking Lot on the right (just beyond the Japanese Gardens entrance on the left). Automated kiosks are available at the entrance of the park and accepts both cash and credit cards.

Woodward Park—6K Course

Course Description

The 6K Course stays true to the classic 5K course run for decades at Woodward Park for meets such as the Kinney/ Foot Locker West and CA State Championships. It is essentially the same course, but with a mostly flat 1K loop added at the "top" of the course. The Start is the traditional starting line on the field next to the Mountain View Shelter. It crosses the field and heads toward the perimeter of the park, first passing to the right of the entrance kiosk before rolling right through the trees and onto the long straight dirt trail that ascends up a rolling hill. At the top, you turn sharply right at the laying log and follow the trail across the street and down the trail to the left. Passing the mile marker at the green metal poles, runners then roll up the incline and turn right before reaching the street, looping around the pond on the right in a clockwise direction. It leads you then toward an open area along the road, across and down a grassy gulch, and back onto paved street for a steep descent. Jump the curb at the bottom of the hill on the right onto the dirt trail, and stay to the left at its base. You then approach the "big hill" at which you stay on the right/main trail for two-thirds of the way up before rolling left, cresting, and then going right on the wide dirt trail. This is the 3k marker. This wide dirt road will weave back towards the BMX stadium and turn left along the dirt parking lot, then left again up a dirt road that takes runners back to the top of the hill climb where they now make a hard right turn and run and follow the traditional 5k course in—from here you follow the trail over some rollers, through the fence near the first disc golf tee box, across the road to the 1-mile marker, and follow the first mile course to the finish line, which is short and left of the start line on the big grass field.

Course Markers

- Start at the traditional starting line on the field next to the Mountain View Shelter.
- 1K is at the branch of the trail that bends toward the pond across the street, neat the top of the long straight hill before the sharp right turn at the log. It is even with the rounded purple sign across the street.
- The 1-mile is at the green posts near the little stream/bridge below the Mountain View Shelter.
- The 2K is 10 meters past the willow tree closest to the trail along the little stream adjacent to the amphitheater.
- 3K is just beyond the top of the big hill climb.
- The 2-mile marker is along the dirt trail about 200 meters past the 3K sign
- 4K is the orange dot tree at the "Y" (GO LEFT ON THIS LOOP).
- The 3-mile marker is 20 meters past the dead tree on the right of the trail after crossing the street and heading to the log turn.
- 5K is at the tall green tree on the right of the trail near the top of the descent of the long straight hill. It has a dirt trail around it and is near the first elevation descent in the block wall block wall behind it.
- 6K is the finish line to the left (and 30 meters short) of the Start.

WOODWARD PARK

Woodward Park—8K Course

Course Description

The 8K Course is essentially a multi-lap version of the classic 5K course. The start is the traditional starting line on the field next to the Mountain View Shelter. It crosses the field and heads toward the perimeter of the park, first passing the entrance kiosk on your immediate left, then the other entrance kiosk to your right before rolling right through the trees and onto the long straight dirt trail that ascends up a rolling hill. At the top you turn sharply right at the laying log and follow the trail across the street and down the trail to the left. Passing the mile marker at the green metal poles, runners then roll up the incline and turn right before reaching the street, looping around the pond on the right in a clockwise direction. It leads you then toward an open area along the road, across and down a grassy gulch, and back onto paved street for a steep descent. Jump the curb at the bottom of the hill on the right onto the dirt trail, and stay to the left at its base. You then approach the "big hill" at which you stay on the right/main trail for two-thirds of the way up before rolling left, cresting, and then going left at the "Y". Stay on the main trail until approaching the paved road, at which point runners bank left around the last planted tree on the left, cross the street, and follow the trail back toward the pond. Follow the same route around the pond and back to the big hill, up the hill the same way, again left at the "Y", and again bank around the last tree before the road. This third loop, however, is abbreviated. Once runners cross the road, they stay straight on the trail, by-passing the right turn around the pond trail. Proceed the same way to the base of the big hill, but rather than going up the hill for the third time, go straight over the small rise to the extreme left and follow that trail to the paved road. Run up the paved road back to the point where you crossed the road on the previous loops. Proceed down the hill with the gazebo on your left this time, headed back to the one mile marker on the trail. The last mile is the same as the first mile, and the finish line is short and left of the starting line on the big grass field.

Course Markers

- Start at the traditional starting line on the field next to the Mountain View Shelter.
- 1K is at the branch of the trail that bends toward the pond across the street, near the top of the long straight hill before the sharp right turn at the log. It is even with the rounded purple sign across the street.
- The 1-mile marker is at the green posts near the little stream/bridge below Mountain View Shelter.
- 2K is 10 meters past the willow tree closest to the trail along the little stream adjacent to the amphitheater.
- 3K is the orange dot tree at the upper "Y".
- The 2-mile marker is at the chunk of cement in the trail shortly after going through the opening in the fence near the 1st tee disc golf.
- 4K is at the green post and rock at the base of the grassy gulch (a parking lot is on the right, before the downhill paved section).
- The 3-mile marker is 40 meters past the 2-mile marker on the same trail (even w/ the second pine tree to the left).
- 5K is even with the "Handicap Parking Only" sign next to the pond on the right.
- 6K is at the first "No Stopping Any Time" sign on the left side of the street at the beginning of the parking area as you run back toward the main street crossing/mile marker on the road.
- 7K is at the tree on the left of the trail near the last leftward branching trail as you go up the incline before the half-mile posts.
- 8K is the finish line to the left (and 30 meters short) of the starting line.
